The Beginning of the End

- **For 3 years Jesus has taught the kingdom**
- **John 12 was the beginning of the last week**
- **The anointing took place several days before the Triumphal Entry**
- **The Holy Spirit revealed the plan with the foal. Lk.19:28-34**
- **Matt.21:1-5 – Colt, foal of a donkey**
- **Prophesied in Zechariah 9:9- 9 Rejoice greatly, O Daughter of Zion! Shout, Daughter of Jerusalem! See, your king comes to you, righteous and having salvation, gentle and riding on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a donkey.**

Jesus' Triumphal Ride

- **It was a large crowd of people**
- **John 12:12, 13**

¹²The next day the great crowd that had come for the Feast heard that Jesus was on his way to Jerusalem.

¹³They took palm branches and went out to meet him, shouting, “Hosanna!” “Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!” “Blessed is the King of Israel!”

Jesus' Triumphal Ride

- **There were some religious people who were offended by people praising God. Lk.19:39**
- **Here are the two groups:**
 1. **Those joyfully praising God for Jesus and works he has done**
 2. **Those offended because the worship was not done in the right form**
- **What do you think God desires? Matt.21:12-16**
- **If those blessed with intelligence do not praise God, the inanimate will!**

Jesus' Triumphal Ride

- Lk.21:41-44
- Jesus lamented their ignorance of truth and the presence of God in their midst
- Jesus prophesied their destruction
 - Enemies will build an embankment and encircle the city
 - Young and old will die
 - Temple would be completely destroyed

Jesus' Future Triumphal Ride

- **Revelation 19:11-21**

¹¹I saw heaven standing open and there before me was a white horse, whose rider is called Faithful and True. With justice he judges and makes war. ¹²His eyes are like blazing fire, and on his head are many crowns. He has a name written on him that no one knows but he himself. ¹³He is dressed in a robe dipped in blood, and his name is the Word of God.

¹⁴The armies of heaven were following him, riding on white horses and dressed in fine linen, white and clean. ¹⁵Out of his mouth comes a sharp sword with which to strike down the nations. “He will rule them with an iron scepter.” He treads the winepress of the fury of the wrath of God Almighty. ¹⁶On his robe and on his thigh he has this name written:

KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS.
