### **What I Think Matters**

- Matt.5:20 -For I tell you, unless your righteousness exceeds that of the scribes and Pharisees, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven.
- Mk.7:20-22 And he said, "What comes out of a person is what defiles him. For from within, out of the heart of man, come evil thoughts, sexual immorality, theft, murder, adultery, coveting, wickedness, deceit, sensuality, envy, slander, pride, foolishness."
- Jhn.5:42- Speaking to the Jews Jesus said, "I know you do not have the love of God within you."

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- The Talk on the Hill is about a changed heart.
- Matt.5:17-31
- The 3<sup>rd</sup> comparison Jesus makes is between a "right way" to divorce and living out a heart of love
- One of the most important things on the minds of men of Jesus day was, "How do I get rid of a wife who does not please me?"
- The Pharisees felt that as long as they gave the statement of divorce, they felt they had done the "right thing"

### **Divorce For Women In Jesus Time**

- Divorce was entirely at the man's discretion
- The woman had no say or voice in the action
- If the man was abusive in the marriage, divorce was not an option a woman could pursue
- There were different schools of thought at that time
- Rabbi Shammai only allowed divorce for immorality
- Rabbi Hillel allowed it "for every reason" eg. burnt or over salted food
- Rabbi Akibah- because a man saw a woman whose appearance pleased him more than his current wife

- Jesus said, One who Divorces, except for the cause of sexual immorality, commits adultery if they remarry.
- This standard is set in Deut.22,24 and repeated throughout the NT, starting in Matt.5:32.
- Matt.19:4-6 Jesus states, Marriage is God's idea.
- In marriage a man and woman become one flesh
- What God has joined, let no one separate

#### 3 Reasons The Old Law Divorce Was Not Good

- It disrupts one of the major relationships God created for us. No one is the same after a divorce.
   who became 1, are torn apart
  - A brutal marriage is not a good thing either. Divorce is not an irredeemable form of wickedness. In some situations, divorce is necessary and a good thing
- 2. Just because you follow the law does not mean you are "right" with God or another person.
- 3. In those days, divorce would "force" women into adultery

- Two exceptions are given in the NT.
- 1. For sexual immorality because of the damage breaking the oneness does to a relationship
- 2. 1Cor.7:12-15 Abandonment If an unbeliever chooses to leave the relationship, let them go.
- 19:7 Why the certificate of divorce?
- Because of the hardness of heart. God's plan was for 2 people to stay together, reflecting God's faithfulness to us, to each other, through loving forgiveness of one another.

- So it is not really sexual immorality, specifically adultery, that is the cause for the exception clause, but rather the hardness of heart that Jesus is identifying as the need for a divorce.
- Many marriages have survived infidelity through forgiveness but no marriage will survive a hard heart.
- That can be caused by over-salted or burnt food or a person more physically appealing than your current spouse.

- How does God deal with his unfaithful bride?
- God appointed the prophet Hosea to be the living example of God's love for His bride. Hosea 1:2
- The message of God's forgiving love is repeated over and over through the book- 1:8-11; 3:1; 14:1-7
- Can we be that way toward an unfaithful spouse?
- Only with a transformed kingdom heart of love that reflects the love and character of God. 5:48

- This is the progression of the Talk on The Hill. How many divorces would there be, if we removed Anger, Contempt and Fantasied Sexual Coveting from our lives?
- 1. First, God deals with our pride and aggression
- 2. Second, our natural human desires and appetites are submitted to the Spirit led mind 1Cor.8:12
- 3. Third, We forgive 70x7 times, like God forgives and loves us Mat.18:21-22
