Being Joyful

⌘ It is a command of God to be Joy-filled

- ⌘ Psalm 2:11 - Serve Jehovah with fear, and REJOICE with trembling. ??
- ⌘ Psalm 32:11 - REJOICE in the LORD and be glad, you righteous; Phil.4:4 – Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again. REJOICE!
- ⌘ James 1:2 – Consider it all JOY when you encounter various trials. Can you command someone to be Joyful?

What Is Joy?

- ⌘ Christmas is the season of good news of GREAT JOY!! Lk.2:10, 14
- ⌘ How would you define “Joy”?
- ⌘ What is the difference between Joy and Happiness?
- ⌘ When was the last time you experienced real Joy?
- ⌘ The emotion of great peace and happiness

Being Joyful

⌘ It is right to use “Joy” and “Suffering” in the same sentence – they are not opposites!

- ⌘ James 1:2 – Consider it pure JOY whenever you face trails of many kinds
- ⌘ Acts 5:40-41; Apostles – flogged, ordered, released, rejoiced Heb.10:34,35 - Joyfully accepted confiscation because you knew ... they had Hope - cf.35
- ⌘ Rom.5:3-5 – We rejoice in our sufferings because we know ...

Defining Joy?

- ⌘ Joy isn't just a smile or a laugh. Joy is something that is deep within and doesn't leave quickly. When we have the joy of the Lord, we'll know it and so will others.
- ⌘ Joy is the deep-seated sense of contented pleasure that flows from our Hope and Peace in knowing and living in the Presence, Power and Promises of God.
- ⌘ Given the lack of global and personal peace today, is it any wonder there is also little true JOY?

Being Joyful, In All Things

⌘ How is it possible to be joyful in all things?

⌘ It begins with what you know or think

- ⌘ James 1:3 knowing that the testing produces ...
- ⌘ Rom.5:3 we know that suffering produces ...
- ⌘ Heb.10:34 because you knew ...
- ⌘ Knowing shapes values which affects responses

⌘ Responses come from what we know- believe-faith

- ⌘ Rom.10:17 – Faith comes from hearing the word of Christ

Being Joyful, In All Things

- ⌘ Heb.11:1 – Faith is being sure of what we hope for and certain of what we do not see - Eph.1:17-19
- ⌘ Faith is seeing the Presence, Power and Promises of God as more real, than the circumstances around you. Cf. Eph.3:16-21
- ⌘ Heb.11:6 Without Faith it is impossible to please God. For those who seek Him must believe that He IS, and that He is the rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.

 - ⌘ Are you studying the Bible and books about Jesus and the Bible?
- ⌘ Hope and Peace flow from knowing and living the truths of God
- ⌘ Joy is the outflow of Hope and Peace filling your mind, talk and friendships

Being Joyful, In All Things

- ⌘ If you do not have faith, you will not have Hope or Peace or Joy
- ⌘ Faith → Hope → Peace
- ⌘ Faith → Hope → Peace → Joy
