The Day Of Atonement

- It was day of Worship, Self Denial, Prayer and Sacrifice that was to make Atonement for sin
- To make reconciliation
- The action of making amends for a wrong or injury
 :he submitted his resignation as an act of atonement
- When you apologize for doing something wrong, that's an act of atonement. Many religions have rituals of atonement, such as Yom Kippur, the Day of Atonement, on which people of the Jewish faith repent for their sins.

Yom Kippur

- □ Lev.16
- Holiest Day in the Jewish Calendar
- Normally Priest had to wash feet and hands
- High Priest had to wash whole body
- Regular sacrifices offered then Atonement Sacrifices
- First a Bull for High Priest and Family confessed over

Yom Kippur

- □ Lev.16:7,8
- 2 goats presented
- Cast of the Lot and Marking of the Animals
- Scape-Goat turned to face people
- Bull then slain and blood sprinkled
- Goat "For Jehovah" slain and blood sprinkled

Yom Kippur

- Blood of two mixed and sprinkled on the alter
- Sins of People confessed over Scape-Goat
- Led into uninhabited land by non-Jew and set free
- If sacrifice accepted red cloth turned white

Yom Kippur Today

- Modern Judaism thinks of Yom Kippur as a day of judgment.
- The 10 days from the New Year, Rosh Hashanah, are days of taking steps to become all the person you can be. It is a self righteousness.
- Yom Kippur becomes a day of Judgement to determine whether one's name will be sealed in the book of life for this year.

Christ in Yom Kippur

- The 2 Goats speak of 2 Covenants
- The Goat "For Jehovah" speaks of the OT, to cover over sin until Christ Came.
- The "la-Azazal" Speaks of Christ.
- He took the sins away.
- "They shall be cleansed" –made white
- Isa.1:18

Proclaim the Lord's Death Until He Comes

- The OT feasts and High days find their fulfillment in Christ.
- Passover found its fulfillment in Christ's death and resurrection
- Sept.25 pm New Year, Feast of Trumpets
- Oct.4 pm Yom Kippur, Day of Atonement
- Oct.9th pm

 Festival of Booths, Living with God, deliverance into the promised land

Christ in Yom Kippur

- Heb.9:5-15; 10:1-4; 8-25
- Christ is our Atonement with the Father
- The Blood of Bulls and goats covered over but did not remove sin.
- Christ, the Sinless Lamb of God, removes our sin.
- Christ, the Scapegoat, carries away our sin as far as the East is from the West!

What Are You Counting On?

- 3 ways people use to get right with God
- 1. Some count on religious ritual to impress God and earn their way to God.
- 2. Some count on good deeds to convince God they are not a bad person and worthy of heaven.
- 3. God says only the perfection of Christ, accepted by faith, is worthy of entrance into His presence. Heb.9:26b-28
