

The Day of Atonement Yom Kippur

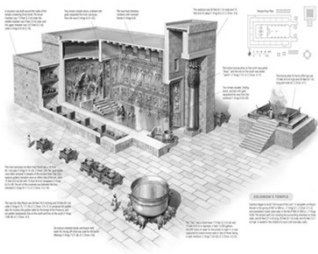
Leviticus 16, 23.

The Earthly Temple

- Rosh Hashanah and the Day of Atonement were not designed to be the solution to man's sin problem, but rather to point to the One who was promised to be the answer.
- The focus on repentance is designed to highlight their need for forgiveness and reconciliation with God and culminates in Yom Kippur, the Day of Atonement.
- This is the holiest day of the year and is a day of fasting and praying to express one's own repentance and need for forgiveness.
- But, in ancient Israel, the Day of Atonement was never a done deal.

The Old System Then: The Temple Rituals



- The Separate Courts
- The Holy Place
- The Cleansing of the High Priest
- The Cleansing of the Holy Of Holies
- The Sprinkling of the Blood
- The Sacrificial Goat
- The Scape goat bearing the people sins released unto Azazel

The Old System: NOW

- No Temple
- No Priesthood
- No Biblical Sacrifices
- The Yearly Spiritual Hamster Wheel of Sin and Forgiveness
- The lack of certainty of Eternal Life

The New Dawn: NOW

- And Jesus uttered a loud cry and breathed his last.
- Mar 15:38-39 And the curtain of the temple was torn in two, from top to bottom. And when the centurion, who stood facing him, saw that in this way he breathed his last, he said, "Truly this man was the Son of God!"
- **Redemption Through the Blood of Christ**
- Heb 9:11- 12 But when Christ appeared as a high priest of the good things that have come, then through the greater and more perfect tent (not made with hands, that is, not of this creation)
- He entered once for all into the holy places, not by means of the blood of goats and calves but by means of his own blood, thus securing an eternal redemption.
