- Isaiah 52:13-53:2; 12

1. Rom.6:5 – Are we united with Him in His Death?

3. Hope perseveres even though God's timing is rarely our timing. Heb.11:13,16
4. It is through resurrections, the glory of God is best shown. In Dark moments, God's Glory shines brightest.
